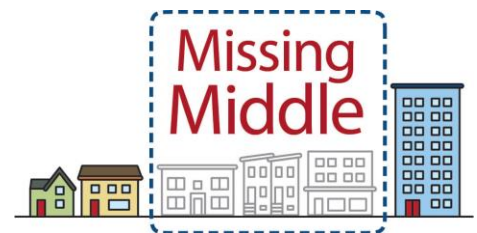
6. What's your favorite restaurant closest to where you live?
